- 2. The applicants are also requested to record a **2-3 minute video** on why they wish to take the leadership program and what is their professional aspiration that inspires them to develop themselves and email it along with the scanned copy of the form.
- 3. Please mention in the subject of the email "Application form for IWDA-L'Oréal Indian Women Dermatologists Leadership Grant"
- 4. Selected applicants would be eligible to attend a **Professional and Personal Leadership** programme online (virtual) once a week for 4 weeks in the months of October- November **2021** with a renowned Leadership Coach.
- 5. After attending the session, the applicants would be expected **to write in 1-2 paragraphs** about their experience and how the session benefitted them. This write-up would be published on the IWDA website.
- 6. The applicants would also be expected to write any scientific paper (case report/ original article/correspondence), preferably on Women's dermatology or pigmentary disorders, and publish the paper in peer –reviewed journals, preferably International Journal of Women's Dermatology (IJWD) or Pigment International (PI) or take alternate suggestions, with due acknowledgment to the IWDA-L'Oréal Leadership Grant. The applicants can also present their work in future events held under the aegis of IWDA subject to acceptance (details to be updated later).
- 7. The certificate for the leadership grant would be subject to the applicants fulfilling the above-mentioned expectations or at least submission of the above. This would contribute to professional and personal development.
